The "BIG" news is that the first draft is now about 49.5% finished! YAY!! (Cue the sparklers, champagne, etc., etc., etc.) Yep. We "put to bed" the scenes leading up to just before the halfway point. So August has been a good month so far.

The novel is sitting right at about 49.5% done on the first draft. I'm estimating because there are a few small tweaks to be made on the material, but my coach and I have gotten the book—in its first-draft status—to the half-way point. I am both happy and sad to report that Ravynn and Benji have made it halfway through the first tour, but "they ain't seen nothin' yet." I'm very happy with the progress the book is making, and I'm convinced that what's yet to come will produce a novel you'll really be happy to read.
